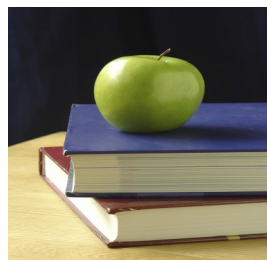

## SESSION INFORMATION

- Sessions will take place after school and will be a full hour between 3:00 and 5:00 P.M.. There are some sessions offered from 7:00—8:00 A.M.. Parents and students will be informed of their scheduling prior to the first session via e-mail. Please note we are unable to guarantee a time slot due to availabilities of tutors. Sessions will be conducted individually or with a maximum of four students per session.
- Sessions will be held for a seven-week period from February 6th to March 30th, 2012 (no classes during breaks). Registration commits student to completing the entire tutoring cycle. Students with an unexcused absence will be dropped from the program. All tutoring absences must be directly reported to Mrs. Pagano.
- *Students may be enrolled for only one course each tutoring cycle.*
- These sessions are intended for students with an 85% average or below.

*Registrations will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.*
